

Monday, Week 4: Mark 10:32

Once again, Jesus took the twelve disciples aside and told them what was going to happen to him... (CEV)

1. Jesus was approaching the end of his earthly ministry, and as he walked ahead of his followers, they were amazed and afraid. One day, they would know him as their Prince of Peace – but not yet. Think about what it cost Jesus to attain the title, “Prince of Peace.”
